FOCUS ON TROPICAL PLANTS FOR THE COLD

Tropical & sub tropical plants hold a lot of interest for plant lovers. Thats because of their amazing colour, shapes and textures. ...not to mention their interesting life cycles. Tropical plants are high energy which vou can utilise to energise yourself!



What Tropical Plants For Cold Areas

1/ Deciduous Tropical Plants

First of all many tropical plants will die down (dormant) in winter. If this is the case it has got a good chance of surviving a cold winter as there will be no above ground foliage to be damaged by the cold.

2/ Some tropical plants are semi deciduous so if something goes adverse with the climatic conditions, at any time of year they drop some foliage so they do not have to maintain it. This is a survival mechanism learnt over thousands of years of adverse weather. In colder climates they will simply shed all their foliage and come back with new foliage in spring.

3/ Some tropical plants have been bred to handle colder conditions such as the Anthuriums being bred in Holland today.


4/ Some tropical plants just need to be kept warm in winter if you are in a cooler temperate area. This means you need a glasshouse, conservatory, igloo or the like that keeps the temperatures above 10oC as a guide.

Some tips for Tropical Plants

1/ Tropical plants are not adapted to being wet and cold together, in winter. They can take wet and they can take dry and they can take heat but not wet and cold especially if they have poor drainage..

2/ Tropical plants especially epiphytes need great drainage. Use a coarse well drained potting mix. This means adding say 25% coarse 10mm diameter bark to your proprietry mix to get the drainage right for winter.

3/ Repot regularly as your potting mix will turn into poorly drained mud in one year.



Beneficial Soil Microbes

In one gram of good productive soil there should be over 15,000 different beneficial species of bacteria, 8,000 species of good fungii and hundreds of species of good algae, protozoae and nematodes! The total numbers of this teeming workforce living within this tiny space may exceed 1,000 million!

DECIDUOUS PLANTS As you know a deciduous plant is one which drops its foliage in the winter months. There are other plants, especially from dry climates, that will also do this to various degrees whenever conditions are unsuitable to it.....eg too hot and dry or too wet (especially in pots which all have imperfect drainage).

Also many gingers naturally drop their foliage and stems and revert right back to their rhizomes in the cooler monthsusually those in the genus Zingiber (eg Z. zerumbet), Curcuma (eg C. australisicum) and Globbo (eg G. winittii) do this.

You should note that plants without foliage **have a low requirement for water** as they are not transpiring through their leaves. They only need enough moisture to keep their tissues from drying & cracking. **Too much moisture will rot them**. Sometimes just lying its pot on its side will keep it dry enough.

Amorphophallus (Snake lillies) species go right back to a bulb. There are many other examples some dropping foliage and stems according to the climate or conditions they are in.

How to Train Your Own Racehorse!

First of all you must feed your horse according to how much work he is doing. You gradually build up the amount of good quality oats he gets and reduce the amount of chaff. Only use the best quality feed and there additions you make to the feed. Make sure he has been shod correctly and get the best farrier and vet available for your horse. Start off trotting only for the first week at least 3200m. If you have access to long work on a beach or private facilities away from a track your horse will benefit from longer distances of slow work.

Your horse will also benefit from doing some work on on a long rein in 20 metre circles.

After trotting for a week let him trot for say 1600 m (a mile) and then half pace for 1600m. Do not let him getaway from you or go any faster untill he is ready for it. Do not let him sprint. The aim is to get him fit and keen to run faster. After two weeks of half pace work...stretch him out to three quarter pace and another two weeks let him out to sprint home the last 300m and gradually sprint the last 600 m but sprint work is only twice a week. Start workig him with another horse is possible. Do some jumpouts from the barriers with other horses first over 600m

Always give your horse a day off and try to make his life interesting. If you have a safe beach with good firm sand as the tide goes out this is ideal. We have won races working only on the beach (Boydtown Beach near Eden) for the entire preparation! 1 Trot one way asking any fishermen to step into the water for your return trip as you will be working faster coming back!

Never overdo his work but get him fit and keen. After about 10 weeks he should be ready to race. For race day you replace his working shoes with light aluminium racing plates and he is ready to go. Some horses are ready to win first up others need a couple of runs to get fit. Good luck.Bob


